Patients should not be transported on a backboard as they are not shown to help. Medics have asked us to take patients off of them in transport, so only use backboards to get patients into the ambulance. Transport patients with a neckbrace on. Backboards can also be used as a splint when needed. If you do remove a patient from a backboard, please document when the patient is removed from it per state guidelines.

We are trying new stethoscopes, which cancel noise and enhance sound to make it easier to get a blood pressure reading. Please leave them in the rig.

Police will no longer be doing background checks per the state. You will need to go to Identogo and be reimbursed. It is unclear whether this includes finger prints. Greg will reach out to the Chief to clarify.

Hospitals are going on divert frequently, so if you are going to the hospital please call ahead to dispatch before you go.

Starting Jan 1st Police officers now have body cameras and are now recording. A red light means the camera is on and green light means it is off. Please be careful what you say in front of them.

Debbie is still on sick leave, Anthony has been covering for her night duty in her absence. We may need to drop to 4 Night teams.
